YARD SALE CONDITIONS

1. Space is limited, and tables will be set up close to the perimeter of the room so you can sit behind them. They will not be set up like a “booth” at the quilt show.
2. Tables cannot be moved around, and all for-sale items must be on or under your individual table.
3. Sellers are responsible for all activities at their table, including:
 - a. Identifying and pricing your merchandise. All items sold must have an identification sticker or price tag indicating exactly who the seller is. (Note – to avoid confusion, use any color except yellow on identification tags and/or fabric bands. Yellow is the color used by the Country Store to wrap fabric bundles.)
 - b. Collecting payment, making change, and providing receipts if the buyer requests one. Since this is a yard sale and you are selling as an individual, you should consult with your tax advisor to see if there are any tax implications for the income you derive from the sale.
 - c. You may sell your merchandise on one or both days of the sale, but please plan on staying open during the entire sale hours.
 - d. Monitor all activities at your table and have a responsible person at the table at all times.
 - e. Clearing your table and removing all your unsold items from the building within 30 minutes of the end of the sale on Sunday afternoon.
4. Should a buyer show up at the Country Store cashier station with a yard sale item, GQCCC will not process that sale and will return the item to the correct yard sale seller.
5. Items brought to the Country Store cashiers with no identification will be assumed to be a Country Store item and will be sold by GQCCC.
6. GQCCC is not responsible for the loss or theft of yard sale items.
