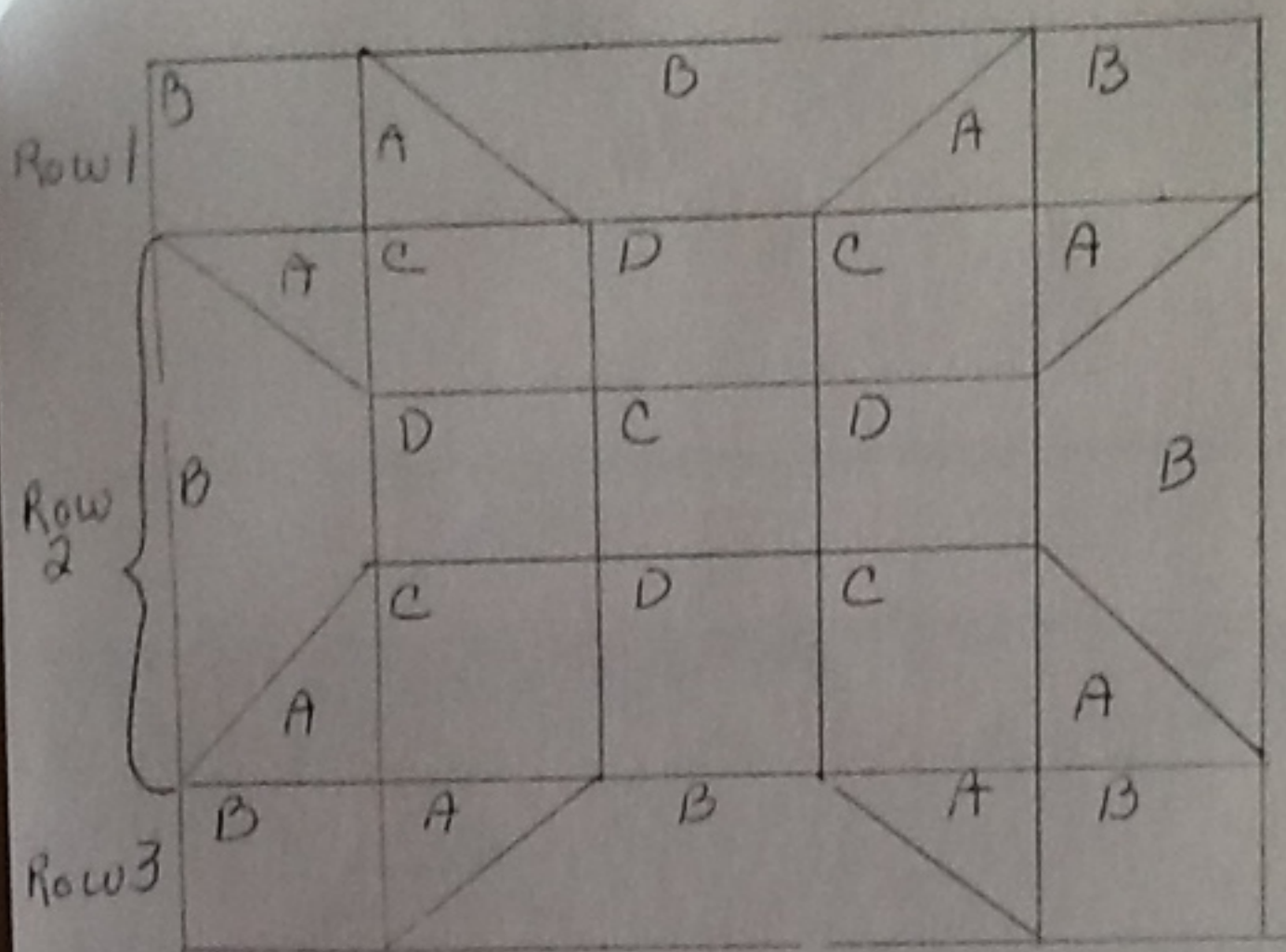

Cutting: Color A: Cut eight 2 ½ inch squares
 Color B: Cut four 2 ½ inch squares AND
 Cut four 2 ½ inch by 6 ½ inch rectangles
 Color C: Cut five 2 ½ inch squares
 Color D: Cut four 2 ½ inch squares

1. Take the eight matching A squares for the star points, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each. Layer a marked square on one end of the B rectangles. Stitch on the diagonal line trim to ¼ inch seam allowance. Flip and press toward the corner. Repeat on the other end of the rectangle. Makes four star point units.
2. For the nine patch sew the C and D squares together in rows to make a 6 ½ inch unfinished block. Press
3. Sew two star point units to opposite sides of the nine patch. Then sew a B square to the ends of the other two star point units and attach to the other two star point units to the sides of the nine patch. Press

Make sure you pin your name on the block.

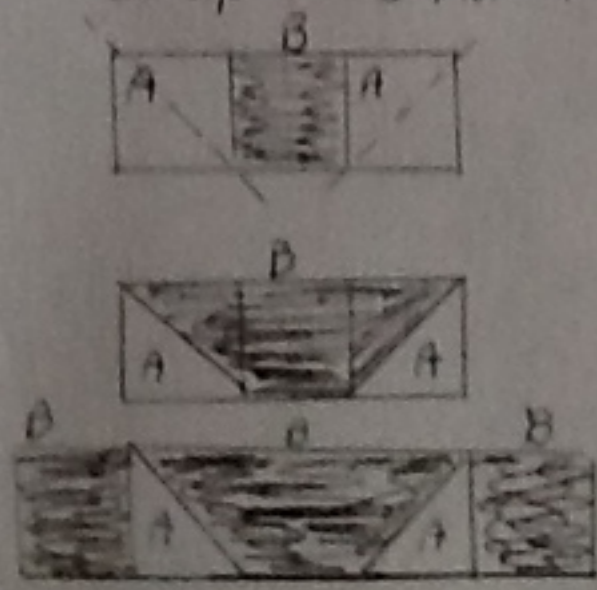
