Ocean Wave

Finished size 10", your block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "

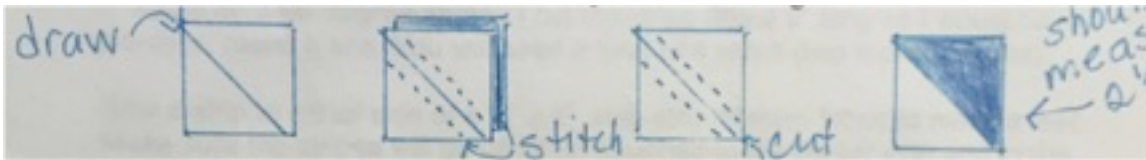
Colors: Pale Blue to pale grey print or solids; Medium to dark blue prints or solids

Pale blue to gray: 1 square $6\frac{7}{8}$ ", cut once diagonally

9 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ "

Medium blue: 9 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ inches

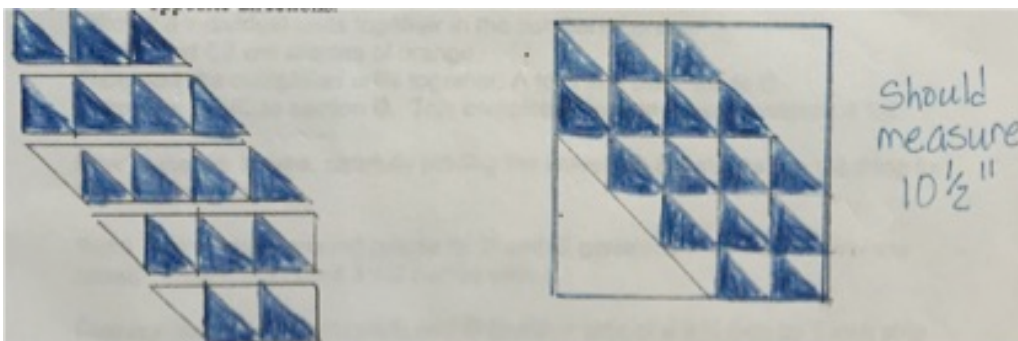
1. On the back of 7 of the pale blue squares draw a diagonal line.



2. Place a marked pale blue square on top of a med. blue square, right sides together. Using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " inch seam, stitch on either side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line, to form $\frac{1}{2}$ " square triangle units. Press seam toward the dark fabric. You will have 14 units, but will only use 13 to construct the block.

3. Diagonally cut the remaining two pale blue and two med. blue $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. You will only need 3 triangles of each color.

4. Assemble the ocean way section as shown. Pressing the seams of each row in opposite directions.



5. Stitch the larger triangles on either side. Press toward the larger triangle.
