Redwood Tree - Applique Version

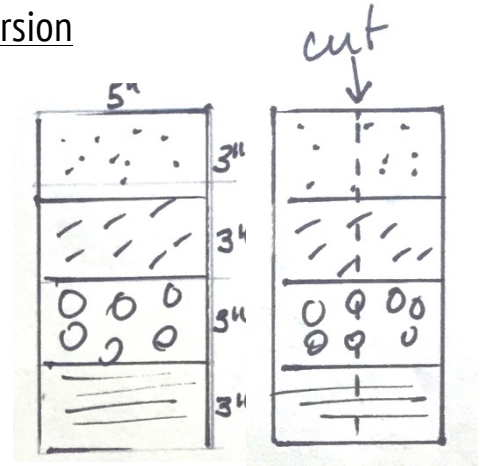
Finished size 4" x 12", your block should measure 4.5" x 12.5".

Colors:

- 4 different beiges or lights
- 4 or 5 dark green prints
- Dark brown for trunk

Directions:

From each beige cut rectangle 3 1/2 x 5". Sew the 4 pieces together to form a long rectangle 5" x 12.5", press seams open.

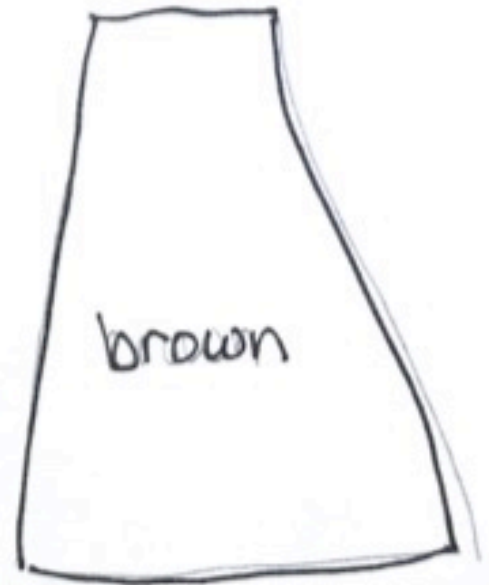
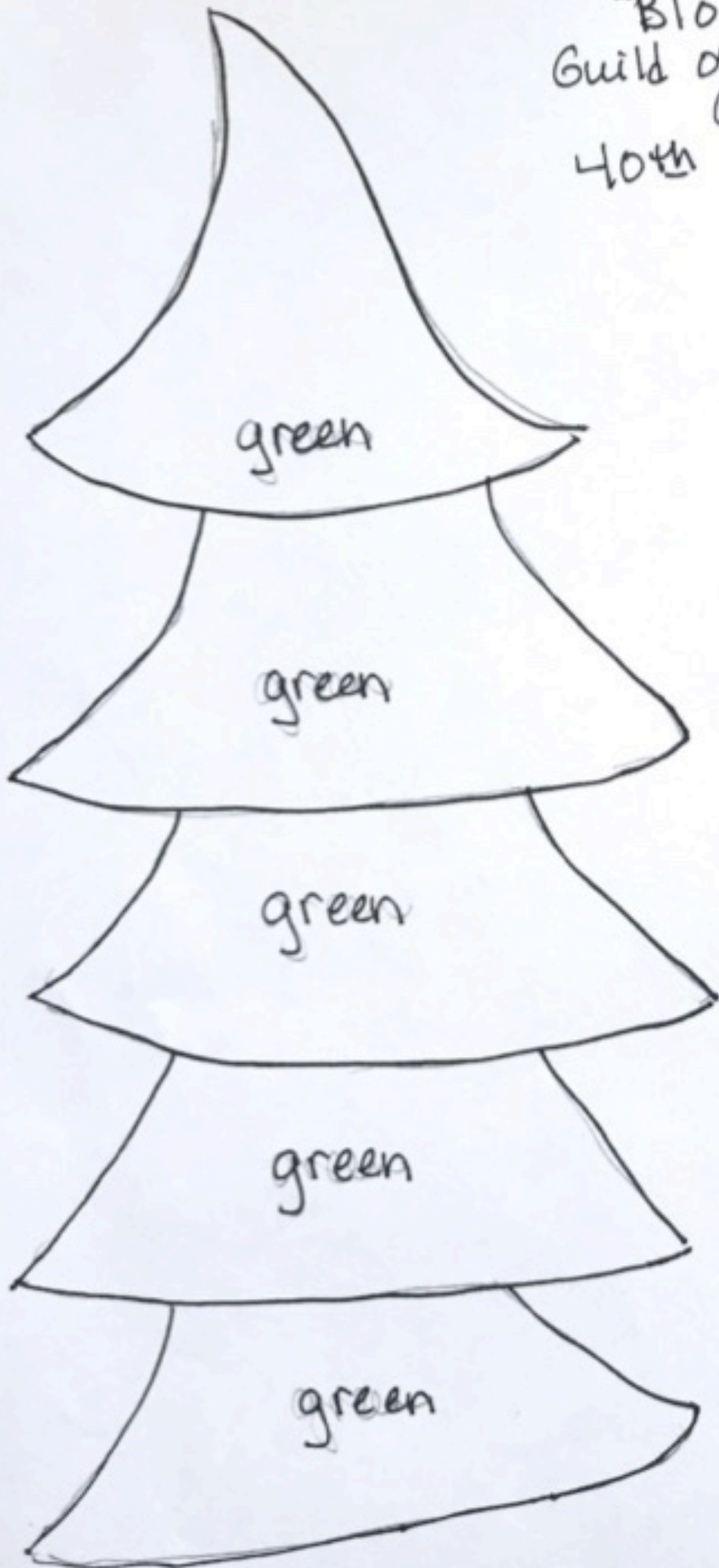


Now cut the rectangle down the center, forming pieces 2.5" x 12.5". Turn one of the rectangles 180 degrees (top fabric will now be the bottom fabric). Pin the two rectangles back together and stitch. Press the center seam open. You now have a pieced background that had different fabrics on either side of the center.

Starting with the trunk, applique the tree to the background. If you use needle-turn, remember to add 1/4" seam allowance.
