Self Portrait - Pattern

Finished size 12" x 12", your block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".

This block of the month pattern from May 1993 was adapted from More Lap Quilting with Georgia Bonesteel, by Oxmoor House. Banners were made from the self0portrait blocks. They are sometimes displayed at our quilt show and at the Farmhouse. *You can take a look at the separate Examples document Portrait posted with all the Anniversary Patterns to see the creativity of how other members have completed their Self Portraits Blocks.* Please turn your portrait in to Raynell Coleman or Ann Gimbel.

Colors:

Light blue background fabric, approx. 12" x 13"

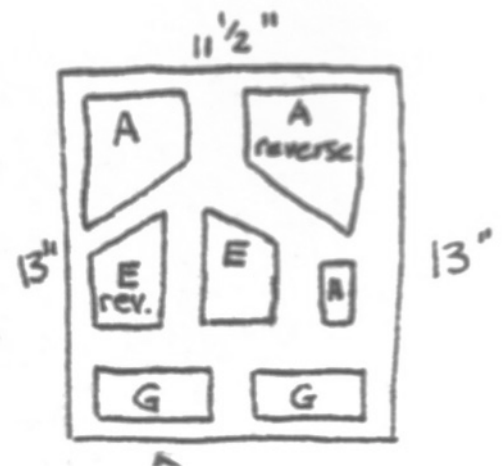
Assorted fabrics to create skin, hair, dress, etc.

Directions:

1. Add 1/3 seam allowance to all pieces when cutting!

2. If a piece says to cut 1 "reversed: it means to cut one piece using the template right side up then flip the template over to cut the second piece. Pieces A, C and E are cut in this manner. This gives you two pieces that are mirror images, i.e. piece C will give you a right and a left arm.

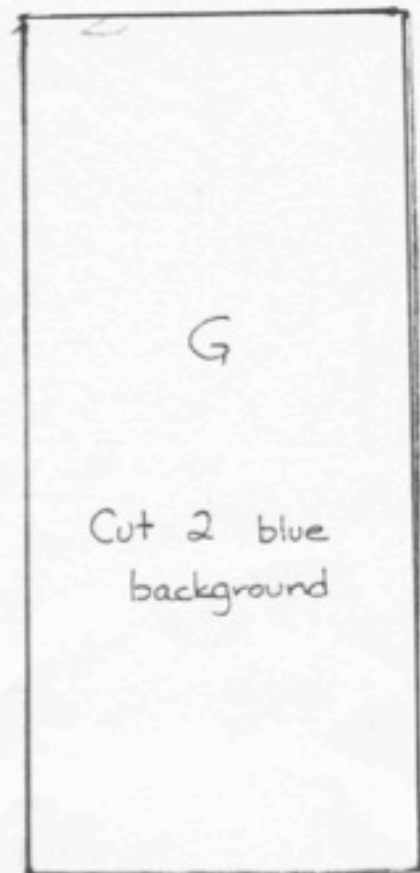
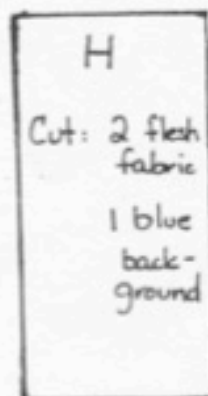
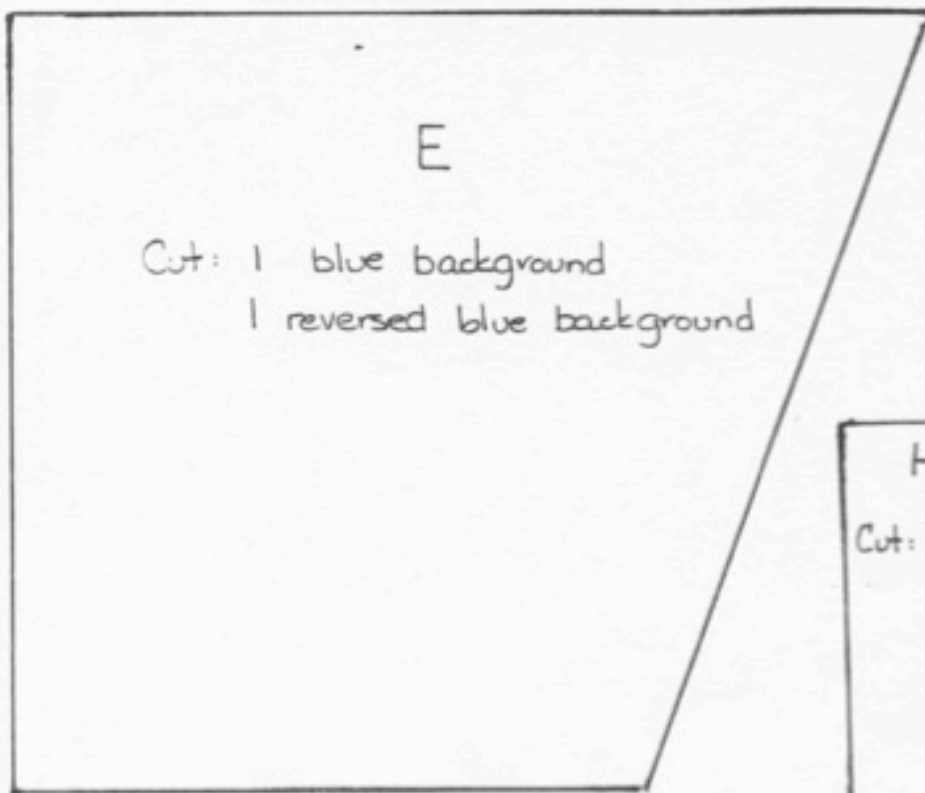
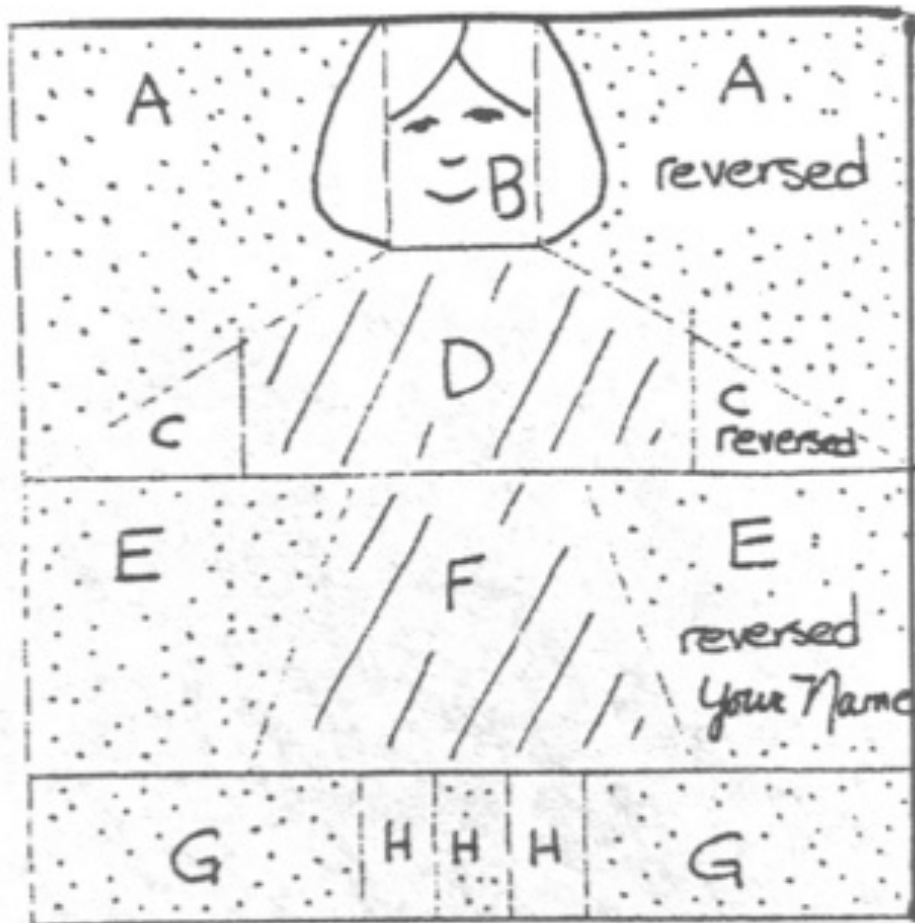
3. Use this diagram to cut your blue background fabric.



4. Sew the pieces together as shown.

5. Use applique, embroidery, permanent pen or other embellishment to add facial features and hair. Be creative! Have fun!

6. Use a permanent pen or embroidery to write your name next to the skirt as shown.



Add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to all pieces

Cut: 1 blue background
1 reversed blue background

Cut 1 flesh fabric

Add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to all pieces.

C

Cut: 1 flesh fabric
1 reversed flesh fabric

Cut 1 dress fabric

Cut 1 skirt fabric
