Wrench

Finished size 10", your block should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½"

I chose this block and colors to represent the coal mines and industrial area of Pittsburg (think steel mill).

Materials:

Black print:

two 4 7/8" squares

four 2 ½" squares

Red, orange or intense yellow

one 2 ½" square

White, white on white, light gray

two 4 7/8" squares

four 2 ½" squares

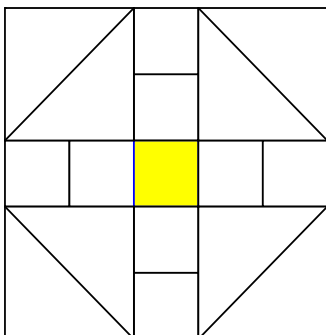
Directions:

On the wrong side of the large white squares, draw a diagonal line. Right sides together pin a large white square to a large black square. Sew a scant ¼" seam on either side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on drawn diagonal line. Press seam toward dark fabric. Repeat with the other pair of large white and dark squares.

Sew a small black square to a Small white square.



Set as shown and stitch together



White will be on the outside corners.
Black will be on the inside, next to the yellow,
Red or orange center.
