Modern Rail Fence

This is just a block for a modern rail fence that I found in a digital book was called "The Practical Guide to Patchwork: New Basics for the Modern Quiltmaker" by Elizabeth Hartman. The block is called Fenced In. I made a few alterations to the size since the block in the book has sashing on it and I want to leave sashing up to whomever wins the blocks. It starts on page 46 of the digital book.

Fabric Requirements: 3 bright purple fat eighths

Instructions:

1. Mark each fat eighth as either A, B, or C
2. From A, cut three strips 1 ½" wide by 9 ½" long
3. From B, cut two strips 2 ½" wide by 9 ½" long
4. From C, cut one strips 3 ½" wide by 9 ½" long
5. Sew strips together in any order as long as the colors are dispersed.
6. The sample block is sewn as A-B-A-B-A-C

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
