July Bowtie Kites

Available at the July 20th meeting Blocks due at September 21st meeting

8" Bowtie Kite Block

This is a simple block to make, in honor of Summer Fun. Cut the following:

2 x 4 1/2" squares light blue 2 x 4 1/2" squares bright fabric 1 x 3 3/8" square dark fabric

Stack the 4 1/2" squares together matching all sides. Measure 2 3/8" from top left corner to center top and mark. Measure 2 3/8" from bottom right corner to center of right side, and mark. Cut between marks and discard top right corners.

Place one side of 3 3/8" square on top of one 4 1/2" square along clipped off corner, matching centers, right sides together. Stitch only within seam allowance, starting and stopping 1/4" from edge. Finger press seam away from center. Stitch all corner pieces to center square in same manner.

Fold center square in half diagonally and stitch seam between two corner patches, starting 1/4" from center corner and stitch all the way to end. Repeat for all side seams. On reverse, finger press all side seams to the left. Gently press from back if desired.

All seams are 1/4."
