



Bring “7” – 5 ½” inch squares of Fabric to December’s Meeting to Play

We are repeating the fun game we played last year, so if you would like to join in this rousing play, please bring seven (7) – 5 ½” squares.

How to Play LRC

1. Ask each attendee to bring the specified amount of fabric from their stash to play.
2. Members will sit in a circle or at a table. Put Scrabble letter tiles L, R and C in a bag and have guests draw a tile, then return it to the bag. The first person to go chooses a letter tile from a bag, then passes one fabric selection to the **left, right** or **center “pot”** in the middle of the table. Alternately, you can assign numbers from a single die: 1 & 2 (left), 3 & 4 (right) and 5 & 6 (center).
3. Eventually, a player will run out of fabric selections. She is “out” and cannot roll the next round unless a fabric selection is passed to her from the **left** or **right**, in which case she is back “in” the game. Continue passing fabric selections around the table in this way until the last person has only one left. She is the lucky winner of all the 5 ½” squares in the center!
4. **You can also play this game with Fat Quarters. OR even poker chips. If you used poker chips (or pennies) you can play this way to award a prize of your choosing (this version even goes over well with families during the holidays)!**
