Block of the Month  
Folded Corners

Finished size: 12 inches


This block is made with a white background and a dark, medium and light fabric in one color, any color you choose.

Cutting directions:


White Background: cut (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square for flying geese  
cut A (2) 5" squares for corner half square triangles  
Light Fabric: cut C (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles  
Medium Fabric: cut D (2) 5" squares for corner half square triangles  
Dark Fabric: cut E (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$  x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square for center  
Cut F (4)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares for flying geese

1. Make flying geese units using your (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " white background square and your (4)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " dark squares using the direction for flying geese found on the last page.
2. Sew flying geese to the (4) light  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles as per diagram and press.
3. Using the (2) 5" white background squares and the (2) medium 5" square place them right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the light square and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the line. Cut on the diagonal line. Press towards the dark. Square to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".


4. Assemble block as per diagram. Sew rows 1 to 3 together. Press center rows seams toward the center. Press rows 1 and 3 towards the dark corner half square triangle. Sew 3 rows together.

## FLYING GEESE



1 Large Square

Materials: Use 1 large square and 4 small squares.




4 Small Squares

$2\frac{7}{8}$ "



Note: Draw a diagonal line on each small square on wrong side of fabric.

Place 2 small squares on top of large square, right sides together. Match corners where shown. Corners of small squares should overlap at center.


Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from drawn line on each side of line. Cut on drawn line.



Open and press to make two of the units shown below.



Place small square on top, right sides together. Match corners where shown.



Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from drawn line on each side of line.

Cut on drawn line. Open and press. Makes 4 units.
