Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.
