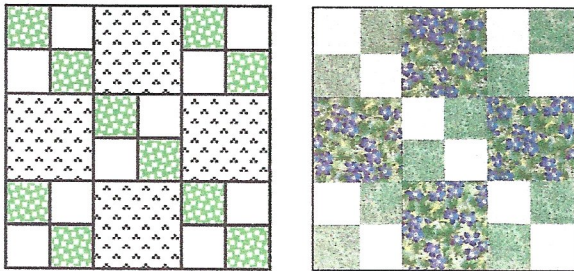


GQCCC Block of the Month

Cutting

White solid or white on white:
Two 2-1/2" x 18" strips

Any floral print:
Four 4-1/2" squares

Light green print:
Two 2-1/2" x 18" strips

NOTE: The instructions to this block specify to use green fabric. Please feel free to use any color or combination of colors your desire.

Assembly

1. Sew the white strips to the green strips.
Press seam toward green fabric.
Cut into ten 2-1/2" units.
Sew units together to make five 4-patch units.
Units should measure 4-1/2".



2. Arrange the 4-patch units with the floral squares to make the Four in Nine block.
Sew into rows. Press seams toward the floral squares.
Sew rows together. Block should measure 12-1/2".
